

# Post-Graduation Immigration Support Program



The Post-Graduation Immigration Support Program aims to support international graduates in Nova Scotia by providing instructional information on immigration programs and personalized immigration coaching.

## To be eligible for an immigration advising session, individuals must:

- Have finished their studies at a post-secondary institution in Nova Scotia in the past year (between August 2021 to date);
- Possess a Post-Graduation Work Permit or proof of application for one; and
- Have a job or job offer from a Nova Scotian employer for a position based and taxed in the province.
